FOREHEAD

"It's been 12 years between these images, yet her brow looks even smoother with time," notes NYC's Dr. Michelle Yagoda. The likely culprit? Botox, which runs \$2K a year.

CHEEKS

"It appears, most notably, that she's had cheek filler," says Dr. Yagoda. "The height between her cheeks and the side of her nose has changed." Cost: Up to \$5,000.

LIPS

"You can barely see her top row of teeth because of too much filler in her upper lip and too much Botox in the general area," shares Dr. Kenneth Mark. The frozen look likely ran upwards of \$1.2K.

JAWLINE

"Fillers along the jawline have given her a square-jawed appearance," observes Dr. Mark of NYC. Injections in the area can set patients back \$3,000.

When Mischa Barton got the boot after just three weeks on last season's *Dancing With the Stars*, it was disappointing. But it definitely wasn't the worst that has happened to her since starring on *The O.C.* from 2003 to 2006.

She's weathered a DUI, financial woes and even a terrifying trip to the psych ward—all struggles that could have dramatically aged the former teen star. Yet at 30, Mischa isn't really showing signs of a hard life. Her secret? Experts believe she's been

bingeing on youth-restoring injections! "Her upper face (eyes, frown, forehead) looks terrific—natural, balanced and ageless," observes NYC dermatologist Dr. Kenneth Mark, who does not treat the actress. "But it goes downhill from there."

Too much Sculptra or Voluma in her cheeks and jawline has obscured her "natural beauty and nice angular features," Dr. Mark adds. Moreover, he blames an abundance of filler such as Juvéderm in her lips and Botox around her mouth for cre-

ating an "overly frozen look in that area." But NYC facial plastic surgeon Dr. Michelle Yagoda (also not Mischa's doctor) insists, "She doesn't look bad. It's just that she is starting to look more generically 'worked on.'" How very *O.C.*
